2023 Service Bundles and Rates

The Smith Child Health Catalyst provides activation energy to advance community and population health, outcomes and evaluation research focused on children and families. The Catalyst team includes scientific leads and content experts who have the knowledge, resources, and skills to support a broad range of quantitative research, qualitative research, and evaluation-related work.

Catalyst services are grouped into five separate bundles and rates, as specified below. Current rate calculations are maintained by the Research Business Office, Stanley Manne Children's Research Institute. Budget estimates provided during scoping are projections. Invoices for exact hours and cost will be delivered to the recipient quarterly and may be either higher or lower than the estimated costs.

| Bundle 3: Qualitative Data Analysis and Reporting | Codebook development, interview and focus group coding, thematic analysis, and report generation | \$52.13 |
| Bundle 4: Quantitative Data Analysis and Reporting | Data cleaning, descriptive statistics, bivariate analysis, statistical modeling, data visualizations, and report generation | \$57.74 |
| Bundle 5: Qualtrics Survey Software | Use of the enterprise Qualtrics account, including user-friendly interface, e-consent, text message distribution, automatic e-gift cards, and intelligent analytics | \$1.26/ initiated survey |
