
Ambulatory COVID19 Screening Workflow (Last Revised: 10/2/20)

Screening Questions:

- 1. Have you, your child, or any member of the household been diagnosed with OR had a positive or pending result for COVID19 in the past 10 days?
- 2. Do you, your child, or any member of the household have a fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain or diarrhea?



- 1. Reschedule appointment for 10 days from last exposure or from last positive test and with resolution of fever and improvement of symptoms.
- 2. For Clinicians Only: Essential visit defined as cannot be safely deferred for 2 weeks as decided by a clinician.
- 3. For Clinicians Only: If non-essential visit is less than 45 minutes of facetime with the provider (i.e., in same room but can be 6 feet from the patient for most of visit) AND less than 15 minutes of direct contact (within 6 feet of the patient during that visit), and the patient/family can be masked, then we see them. If not (e.g., PT/OT/speech, etc.), reschedule.
