



INCLUSION

- 28 d/o – 2 y/o
- Impression bronchiolitis

EXCLUSION

- No CV/Pulm disease or other chronic disease
- FH of asthma or allergies
- By report, response to bronchodilators
- Auscultation of wheezing only (ie no rhonchi)
- Mod to severe resp distress

CONSIDERATIONS

-2014 AAP Bronchiolitis Guidelines **do not** recommend use albuterol and/or racemic epinephrine

Admission Guideline

MOU Exclusion Criteria:

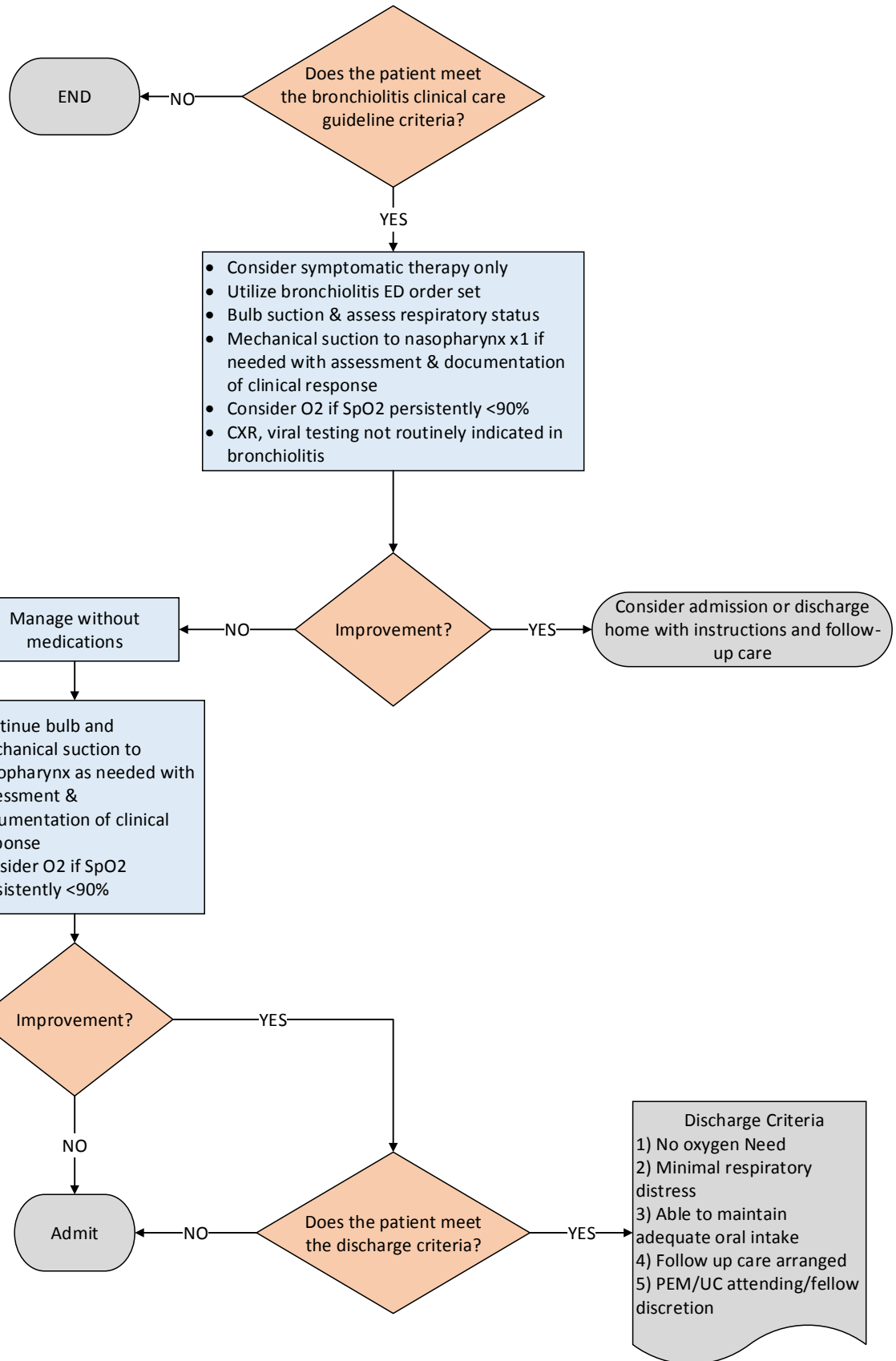
- 1) Age > 2 months old in term Infants
- 2) O2 requirement in selected patients:
< 4 months: Any O2 req.
≥ 4 months: >1L or >25% O2

MOU/Gen Med /CDoc

Exclusion Criteria:

- 1) Intubation
- 2) NCPAP
- 3) HFNC
- 4) O2 requirement ≥50% O2
- 5) Continuous albuterol ≤ 1 year old
- 6) PEM/UC attending/fellow discretion/concern

Admit to NICU, PICU/CCS, or CCU if the patient meets the above criteria.
