Age	Recommended Vaccines and Screenings
<b>Newborn</b>	Exam Weight check Jaundice check Hepatitis B <i>(if not already given)</i>
<b>2 weeks*</b>	Weight check <i>(if needed)</i>
<b>1 month</b>	Exam
<b>2 months</b>	Exam DTaP – Hib – IPV PCV13 #1 Rotavirus #1 Hepatitis B #2
<b>4 months</b>	Exam DTaP – Hib – IPV PCV13 #2 Rotavirus #2
<b>6 months</b>	Exam DTaP – Hib – IPV PCV13 #3 Rotavirus #3
<b>9 months</b>	Exam PPD <i>(if needed)</i>
<b>12 months</b>	Exam MMR Varicella PCV13 #4 Hepatitis A #1 Hemoglobin/Lead level
<b>15 months</b>	Exam DTaP #4 HiB #4
<b>18 months</b>	Exam Hepatitis A #2

Age	Recommended Vaccines and Screenings
<b>2 years</b>	Hemoglobin/Lead level
<b>2½ years</b>	Exam Catch-up vaccines Lead level
<b>3 years</b>	Exam Catch-up vaccines Lead level
<b>4 years</b>	Exam DTaP – Polio MMR – Varicella Vision screening Hearing screening PPD <i>(if needed)</i>
<b>5–9 years</b>	Yearly exam Catch-up vaccines Vision screening <i>(at 7 years)</i>
<b>10 years</b>	Exam Catch-up vaccines Lipid (or cholesterol) screening Vision screening
<b>11 years</b>	Exam Tdap MenACWY #1 HPV #1 PPD <i>(if needed)</i>
<b>12–15 years</b>	Yearly exam HPV #2 <i>(if HPV #1 given at &gt; 15 years, needs 3 doses)</i>
<b>16–18 years</b>	Yearly exam MenACWY #2 Men B



**Flu vaccine is given yearly starting each fall for children 6 months and older. Your child may also be eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine depending on their age. Discuss with your provider.**

\*May not be considered routine wellness care by some commercial insurance policies and may not be covered at 100 percent.
