# GOALS

- Goals of the resident IR rotation
  - Understand the differences between adult IR and pediatric IR
  - Be able to describe pediatric specific diseases which can be managed by pediatric IR
  - Be able to describe the diagnostic and treatment approach to vascular malformations

# WORKFLOW

- First day: Show up at 730 on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and head to the IR suites in scrubs.
- Rotation hours: 7:30 AM-5:30 PM
- The rotation is primarily fellow driven; however, residents can double scrub cases with fellows. If there is a concurrent case in another room, the resident has the option of being primary on that case with an attending.
- Residents are expected to assist fellows in obtaining consents.
- If a resident is primary on a case, appropriate documentation needs to be completed. This includes:
  - Pre-operative notes should be performed prior to patient entering IR suite. Pre-op notes are only required for outpatient general anesthesia cases.
  - After completing a case- EPIC procedure note, a PACS dictation and PACU orders should be performed for all patients.
- Wednesdays are Neuro IR days and residents have the option of participating in those cases.
- Third Wednesday of the month is Vascular Lesion Clinic. VLC takes place on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor from 8am-11am and formal attire is required.
- Fellows take call for a whole week and an additional weekend a month. Residents are not expected to take call.
