<b>6 Months</b>	Pentacel #3 3rd DTaP 3rd HIB 3rd IPV Pevnar #3 Rotateq #3	<b>11 Years</b>	Tdap Menactra #1 Gardasil #1 (2 part series) PPD (if indicated)
<b>9 Months</b>	Hepatitis B #3	<b>12-14 Years</b>	Yearly exams Gardasil #2 (if Gardasil #1 ≥15 years, needs 3 part series)
<b>12 Months</b>	MMR Varicella Pevnar #4 Lead/Hemoglobin level PPD (if indicated)	<b>16-18 Years</b>	Yearly exams Menactra #2 Trumenba (if indicated)
